Procedures & FAQs

- Elementary Students must arrive at the Kavli Theatre by 3:15 pm for mandatory rehearsal.
- Elementary Students must be picked up from rehearsal at <u>5:00 pm</u> and return at <u>6:30 pm</u> call time.
- · Elementary parents must park and escort their child to the designated drop-off/pick up area. (There will be signs to direct you and a detailed video with directions and maps will be emailed prior to the event.)
- Parents who have not formally registered as volunteers with CSF will NOT be permitted in the backstage area. Contact your teacher for more information about volunteering.
- Dress is school's concert attire; teachers will provide site specific information.
- The Theatre will open for seating 45 minutes before concert begins.
- Approximate length of the concert will be 75 minutes.
- Following the concert, elementary students must be <u>picked up</u> by parents at the drop-off location.
- Middle & High School students will be instructed by their choir teachers on pickup procedures.
