The 22nd Annual All District Chorus Festival will take place in the Fred Kavli Theatre at the Bank of America Performing Arts Center located at 2100 E Thousand Oaks Boulevard.

Elementary students who have registered for Chorus through CRPD will receive one digital ticket per semester registered. Tickets will be sent to the email address used to register 2 weeks before the concert.
(Performers do not need a ticket)

Additional tickets can be purchased online through Ticketmaster or at the Box Office (during business hours) for \$18.50 including fees or \$15.50 for a child ticket. A limited number of premium seats are available for \$25 each.

(Children lap sitting do not need to purchase a ticket in advance but must request a free ticket at the box office for admission.) Visit conejoschools.org for more info.)

Parking is available in the parking garage for free until 5:30 pm. Those parking in structure after 5:30 pm will be charged \$15 per vehicle. (Limited street parking available, please follow all posted rules and regulations.)

Procedures & FAQs

- Elementary Students must arrive at the Kavli Theatre by **3:15 pm** for rehearsal.
- Elementary Students must be picked up from rehearsal at **5:00 pm** and return at **6:30 pm** call time.
- Elementary parents must park and **escort** their child to the designated drop-off/pick up area. (There will be signs to direct you and a detailed video with directions and maps will be emailed prior to the event.)
- Parents who have not formally registered as volunteers with CSF will **NOT** be permitted in the backstage area. Contact your teacher for more information about volunteering.
- Dress is black pants/skirt and white shirt.
- The Theatre will open for seating 45 minutes before concert begins.
- Approximate length of the concert will be 75 minutes.
- No outside food, drink or gum is permitted in the theatre. This is for both performers and audience members.
- If your child is sick please keep them home, we want to keep everyone involved as healthy as possible.
- Please note that there are no assigned seats for these performances.
- Following the concert, elementary students must be picked up by parents at the drop-off location.
- Middle & High School students will be instructed by their choir teachers on pickup procedures.
